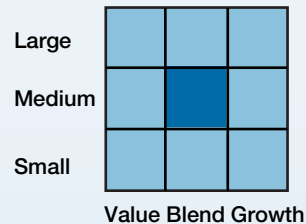
## Investment Objective

The KEELEY Small-Mid Cap Value Fund seeks long-term capital appreciation through investments in small and mid sized market capitalization companies that the adviser believes are undervalued. The Adviser defines small and mid market capitalization as securities within the range of the Russell 2500® Value Index at the time of investment. The market cap range of the index changes daily, and as a result, the capitalization of small and mid cap companies in which the Fund invests will also change.

## Philosophy

In the broadest sense of the term, companies undergoing major change are often characterized as “restructuring” situations. These events include emergence from bankruptcy, mergers and acquisitions, and full-scale corporate reorganizations, such as spinning off or divesting a division. In our experience, there are often extremely complex stories behind the moving parts, making information on the companies involved difficult to synthesize in a timely manner. As a result, many investors choose to avoid these stocks altogether—leading to temporary mispricing.

The Fund's adviser has contractually agreed to waive a portion of its management fee or reimburse the Fund if total ordinary operating expenses during the current fiscal year as a percentage of the Fund's average net assets exceed 1.39% for Class A Shares and 1.14% for Class I Shares. The waiver excludes expenses related to taxes, interest charges, dividend expenses incurred on securities that a Fund sells short, litigation expenses, and other extraordinary expenses, brokerage commissions and other charges relating to the purchase and sale of portfolio securities. The waiver is in effect through February 28, 2024 and neither the Fund's adviser nor the Fund can discontinue the agreement prior to its expiration.
